

“Fast Play Jackpot Boost” Promotion **Terms**

Purpose

The North Carolina Education Lottery (“NCEL”) is conducting a promotion to provide purchasers of Fast Play games an opportunity to win a jackpot that is boosted \$20,000 once per day for five consecutive days.

Promotion Period

The Fast Play Progressive Jackpot Boost promotion begins on Tuesday February 6, 2024 at 5p.m. eastern time and will run for five consecutive days. The final Fast Play Jackpot Boost of \$20,000 will occur at 5 p.m. eastern time on Saturday February 10, 2024).

These dates and times are subject to change at the sole discretion of the NCEL (the “Promotion Period”).

Promotion Execution

HOW TO QUALIFY:

The Fast Play progressive jackpot will continue to function as specified in base game rules. The additional sum of \$20,000 will be added on top of the existing progressive jackpot balance at time of the Jackpot Boost. While the Jackpot Boost is planned for 5 p.m. eastern time the lottery is not responsible if the actual Jackpot Boost does not occur at this time. Any Fast Play game ticket purchased during the Promotion Period will qualify to participate in the Fast Play Jackpot Boost promotion.

MUST BE 18 TO PLAY. Offer valid (fill in dates) while supplies last. The overall odds of winning a Fast Play game does not change as a result of this promotion. Void where prohibited.
